However, recent natural disasters are threatening to close the gates of the Okefenokee Swamp Park. The major droughts and swamp fires of 2007 and 2011 have dramatically reduced operating income and destroyed some of the park's attractions, including parts of the tower and connecting walkway. It has been over 60 years since we have asked for community funding and now we really need YOUR HELP. Our directors are volunteers, who serve without pay and who are committed to preserving this unique opportunity for world-wide travelers.
